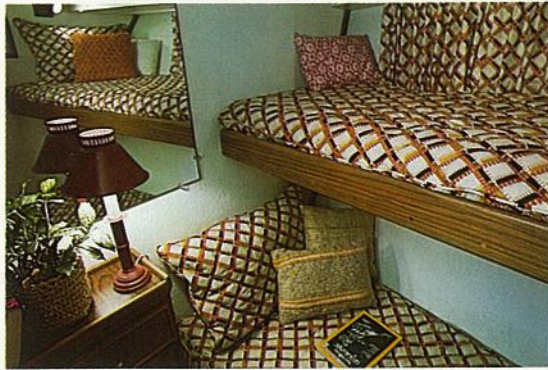


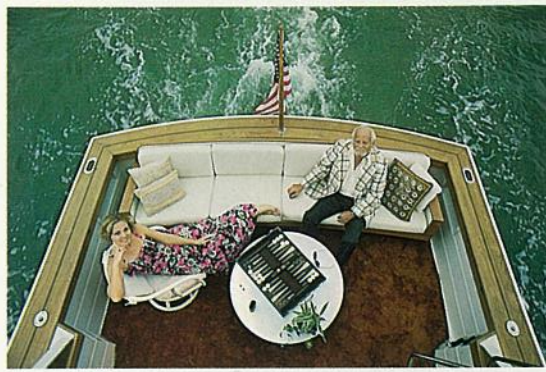

The Commander's standard power is twin Chris-Craft 330's, which means you've got great cruising speed. Your

option is twin diesels.

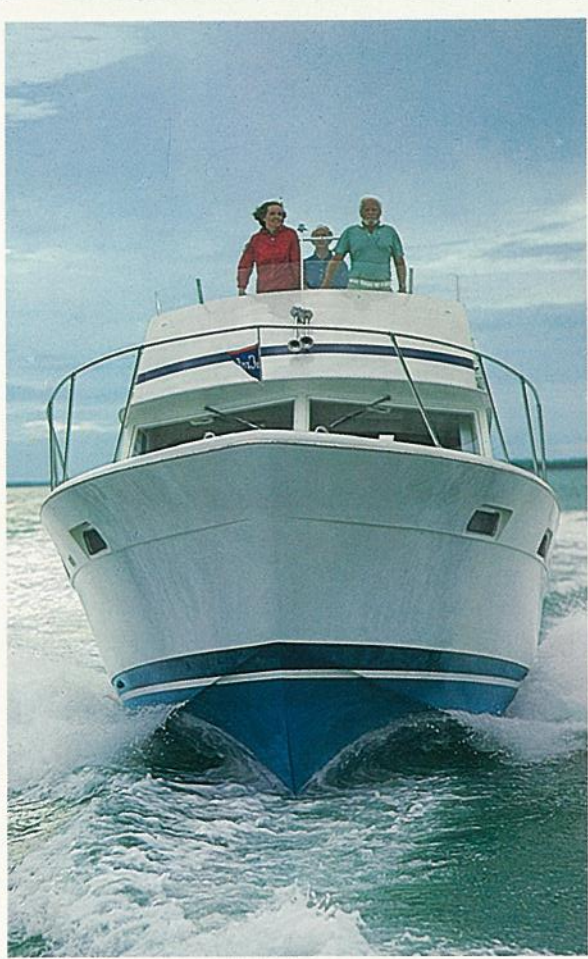

All counters and table corners are rimmed with teak. The head and galley are, in a word, complete. The head includes a stall shower. The forward stateroom is bigger than before, with large, plush V-berths and teakwood drawers. And with an optional filler that gives you a full-sized double bed.

Below, you can choose a separate control station for the salon, air conditioning, and you name it. In the aft cockpit, you can add enough fishing gear

to go after anything that swims. The deck hatches are flush, so whether you're fishing or partying, you won't be stubbing your toes.
